## **Baptismal Information Sheet**

**When will I be baptized** - Baptism is offered the first Sunday in March, June, September, December. Please be advised that dates are subject to change.

When to be here – All those being baptized should arrive at the church for worship service at 11:00 am. All family and friends should also plan on arriving for the 11:00 am.

Please have a seat to the left of the stage as you enter the sanctuary. You'll need to check in with *Min. Jeqwila Calvert* once you arrive to receive some additional information and we get a final count for baptism. You can sit with your family, but we ask you to stay in the general area as it will help with timing when baptism begins.

What to wear and what <u>not</u> to wear: Feel free to arrive dressed in your baptism clothes. Sandals as a great option and saves time. If you need to change clothing, please inform *Min. Jeqwila Calvert* at checkin.

- Ladies, are required to wear a darker colored shirt made of heavy fabric and pants or longer shorts. Darker, thick t-shirts are acceptable. No white colored clothing is recommended nor permitted.
- Men, are required to wear a darker colored shirt made of heavy fabric and pants or longer shorts. Darker, thick t-shirts are acceptable. You may also wear modest swim trunks or board shorts with your shirt. No white colored clothing is recommended nor permitted.

What will happen – Order for Service (subject to change):

- Praise and Worship
- Baptism explanation and introduction
- Everyone getting baptized will be asked to stand and line up across the front of the stage
- Shepard Davis and an assistant will enter the baptismal tank and motion for the first person to join them.
- Hand your towel to one of the assistants by the tank. There are stairs at the tank and someone to help you in and out of the tank.
- After exiting the tank, take a minute to dry off before you return to your seat and celebrate with others that are being baptized.
- You are free to change into dry clothes in the classrooms and/or restrooms.

**Other** – Family and friends are welcome to take pictures of your baptism. The best vantage point may be from the center aisle. If you have any additional questions, please feel free to contact *Min. Jeqwila Calvert* at 414-736-6398.
